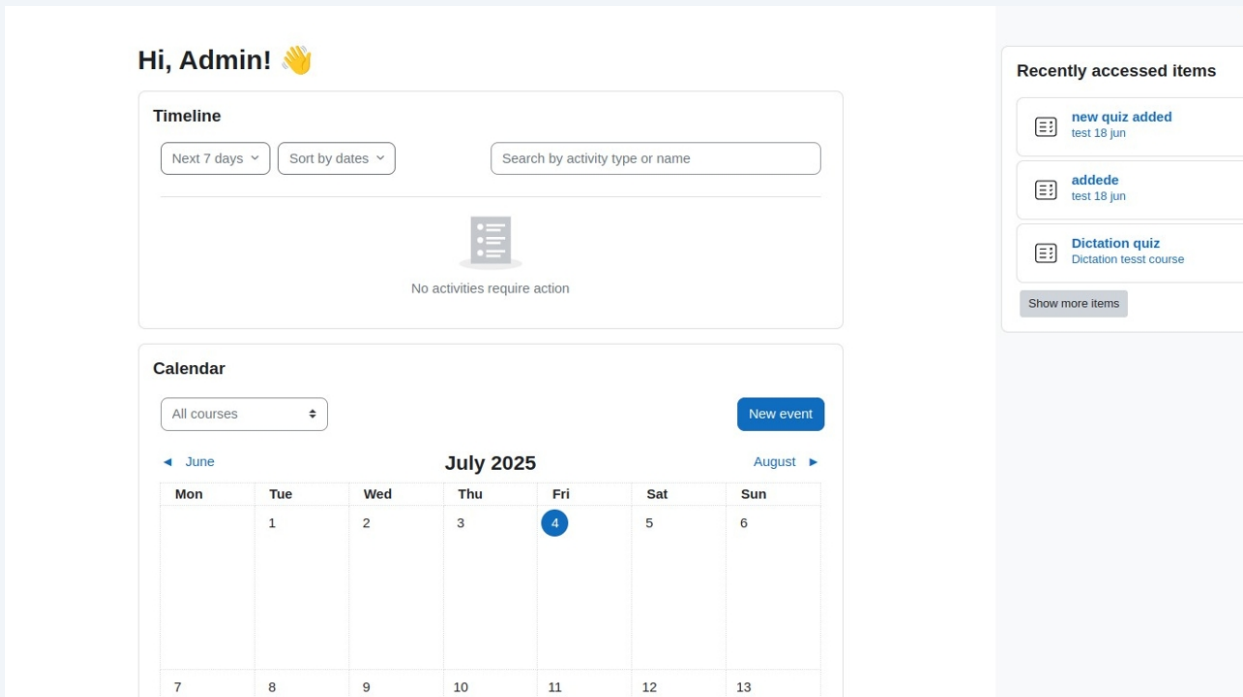


Creating a Quiz with Dictation Questions



1 Navigate to your website.



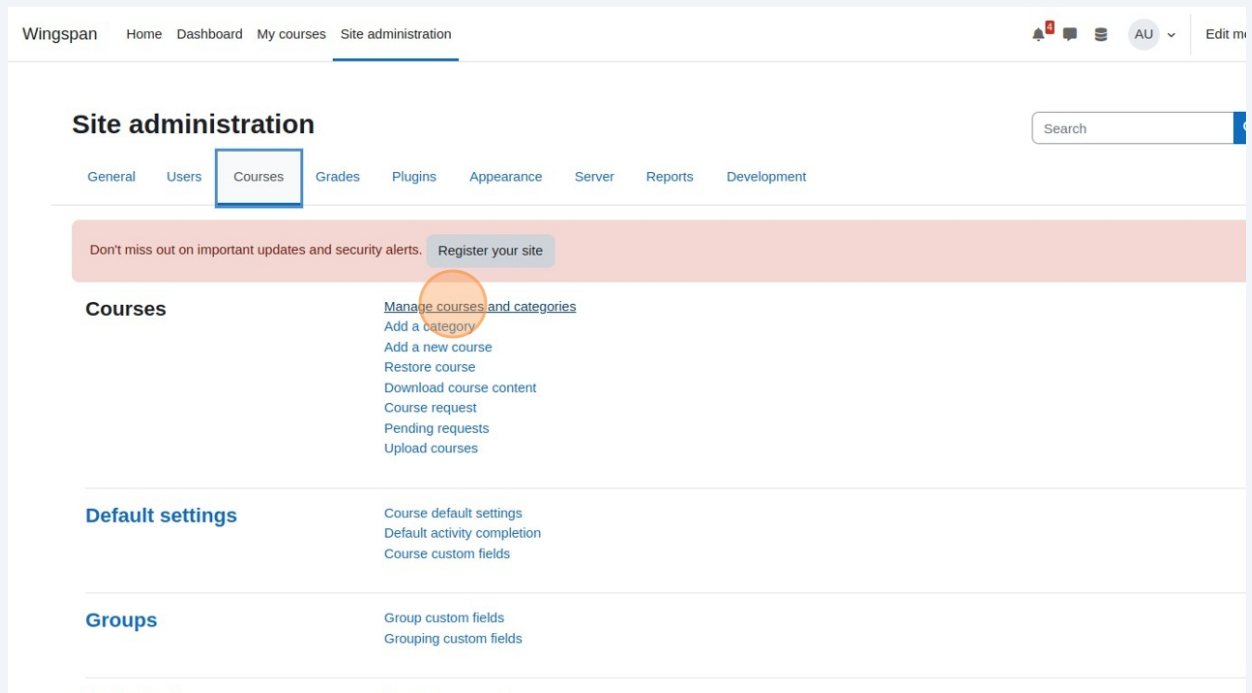
2 Click "Site administration".
